

## **Louisville Institute Announces New Board Members**

As of June 1, Michael Jinkins, Verity Jones, and Amy Plantinga Pauw began terms of service on the Board of the Louisville Institute. At the same time, three Board members completed their terms: Shawnthea Monroe, Dianne Reistroffer, and Dean Thompson.

The Reverend Dr. Michael Jinkins becomes the Ninth President of Louisville Seminary on September 1. He currently serves as Academic Dean and Professor of Pastoral Theology at Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary, where he has taught since 1993. An ordained Minister of Word and Sacrament in the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), he served in pastoral ministry for fourteen years prior to his time in Austin.

The Reverend Verity Jones is currently Associate Director of the Wabash Pastoral Leadership program. From 2003-2009 she served as Publisher and Editor of *Disciples World*, an independent journal of news, opinion, and mission for the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). She holds ministerial standing in both the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) and the United Church of Christ. From 1997-2003, she served as pastor of the Central Christian Church in Terre Haute, Indiana.

Dr. Amy Plantinga Pauw is the Henry P. Mobley, Jr., Professor of Doctrinal Theology at Louisville Seminary, where she has taught since 1990. She teaches in the areas of Reformed theology, feminist theology, and Christian practices, among others. A member of the Editorial Board for *The Works of Jonathan Edwards* at Yale University Press, she is also the Consulting Editor of the *Theological Commentary on the Bible* at Westminster John Knox Press.
